Recycle Right!

YES! METAL CANS

empty & clean - aluminum cans,
steel food cans, aerosol cans
(lids & tips removed)



YES! PLASTIC BOTTLES, JARS, & JUGS

Clean, empty, plastic bottles & jugs, including
pop and shampoo bottles, milk,
juice, water, laundry detergent,
peanut butter, bleach bottles.
Lids may be left on.



YES! PAPER & CARDBOARD

junk mail, newspapers & inserts,
magazines & catalogs, phone books,
flattened cardboard boxes,
flattened cereal & snack
boxes, clean pizza boxes.



**Remove & throw away all
plastic & Styrofoam packing material.
Flatten all boxes.**

YES! GLASS BOTTLES & JARS

Clean, empty, glass bottles, jars and
jugs, any color. **NO** light bulbs, vases,
dishware, drinking glasses, cookware,
serving ware, ceramics

The following items **CANNOT** be recycled in the Community Recycling Boxes

- Styrofoam
- Cups of any type
- Plastic microwave dishes
- Margarine, cottage cheese, yogurt containers, and similar tub-like containers
- Plastic bags, plastic toys, plastic dishes
- Batteries
- Hinged takeout containers
- Kitty litter buckets, other buckets, or pails
- Potting containers for plants (pots, trays, cell packs)
- Motor oil, herbicide & pesticide containers
- Light bulbs, windows, ceramics, drinking glasses, glass cookware or serving dishes, mirrors of any kind
- Paper towels, Kleenex, napkins
- Food waste
- Clothing, fabric, towels, etc.

or double ply cardboard, it may be easier to cut them into panels or pieces, instead of trying to flatten them.
